**Non-Contracted Medicare Provider Appeal**

A non-contracted provider is permitted to file a standard appeal for a denied claim only if the non-contracted provider completes a waiver of liability statement, which provides that the non-contracted provider will not bill the enrollee regardless of the outcome of the appeal. Appeals received without the waiver of liability or other appropriate documentation will result in dismissal of your appeal.

The appeal must be in writing and sent within 60 calendar days from the date of the notice of organization determination. Include the reason for the appeal and other documentation that supports the provider's request.

A decision will be made within 60 calendar days of receipt of the appeal. If the plan's decision affirms, in whole or in part, its adverse organization determination, the complete file will be sent to the independent review entity contracted by CMS.
